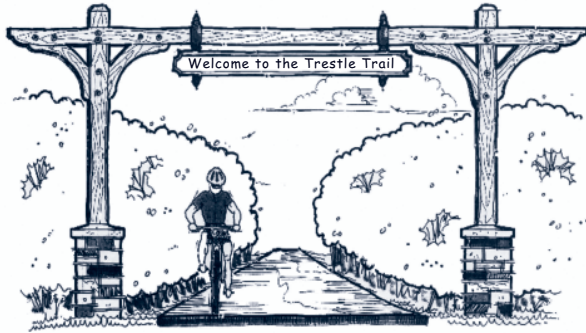


Our Passion

Our Projects

- Facilitate extension of area Trails:
 - 1.) The Friendship Trail from Menasha to High Cliff State Park
 - 2.) The CE Trail eastward along the CE to Weiler Road then toward the Fox River Trail
 - 3.) Recreational trail linking High Cliff State Park and Calumet County Park
- Provide support for completion of the Newton Blackmour Wildlife Trail between Seymour and New London and formation of the Newton Blackmour Wildlife Trail Friends Group.
- Collaborate with regional agencies in support of the Fox-Wisconsin Heritage Parkway and related water trails, portage trails and bicycle/pedestrian routes.
- Continue support for development and linkages of the Fox Cities Paper Trail, a 42-mile trail loop linking the Fox Cities.

Trestle Trail Project

The Trestle Trail was a joint community effort with the City of Menasha, the Town of Menasha, Fox Cities Greenways and Friends of the Fox. The 1,600 ft. trail is the longest pedestrian trail across water in Wisconsin. It features fishing platforms, observation platforms, a pavilion, and amenities on either side of the trail with Fritse Park and the Menasha Lock. Enjoy the water from a unique perspective!

Fox Cities Paper Trail

This joint Fox Cities communities effort will result in a comprehensive bike trail in the Fox River Valley. The trail will be a signed 42-mile loop through some of the most beautiful areas in the Fox Cities. It will eventually allow access to the Trestle Trail, the WIOUWASH Trail, and High Cliff State Park.

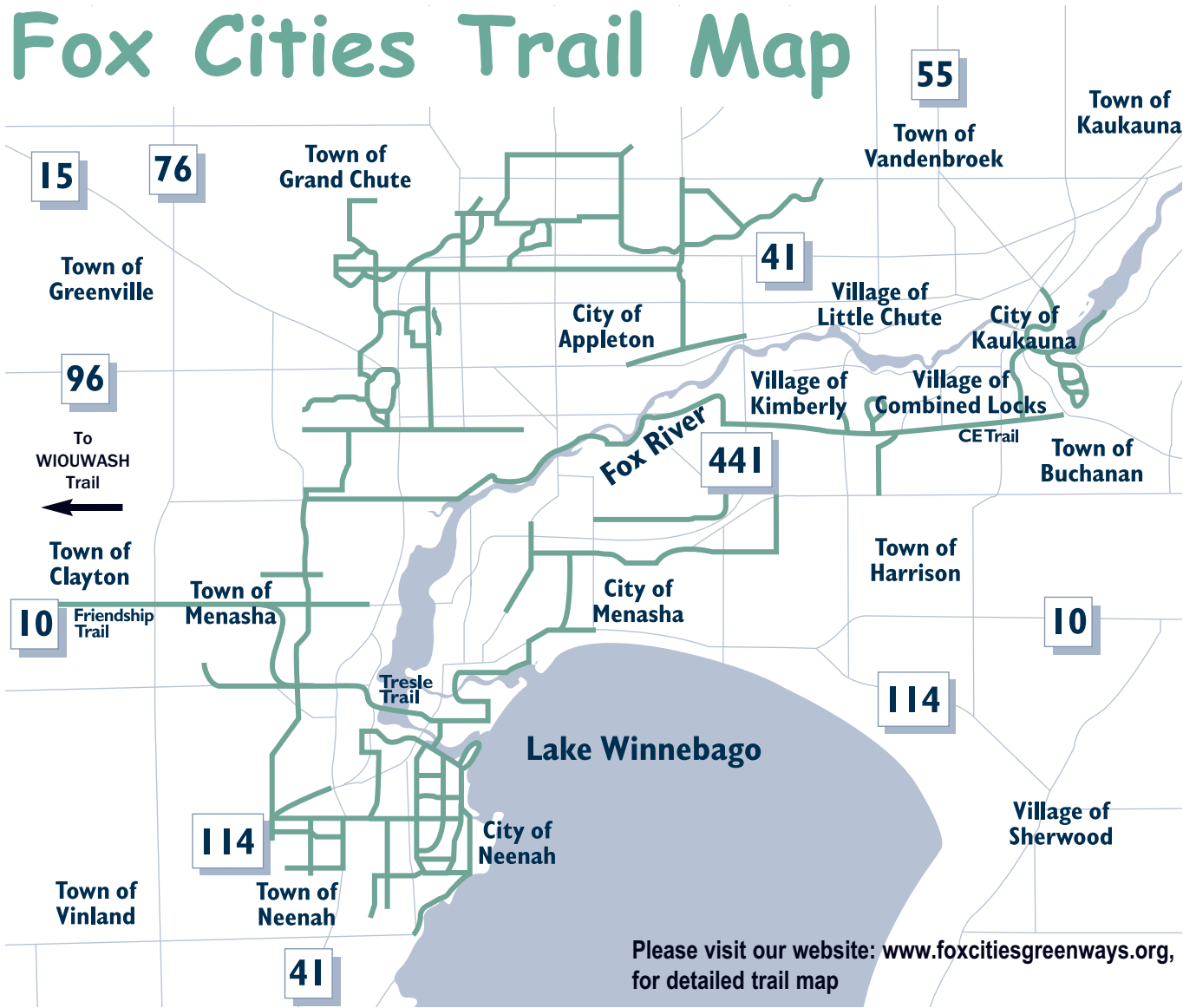


Supporting greenspace and trails in the Fox Cities
