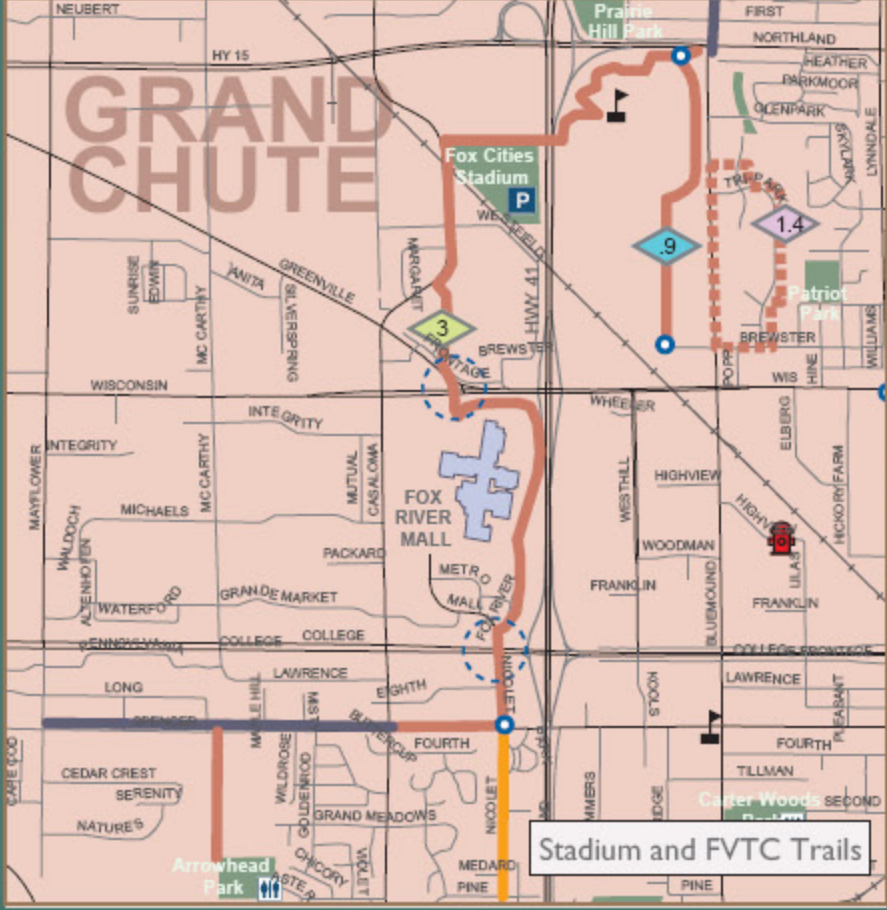
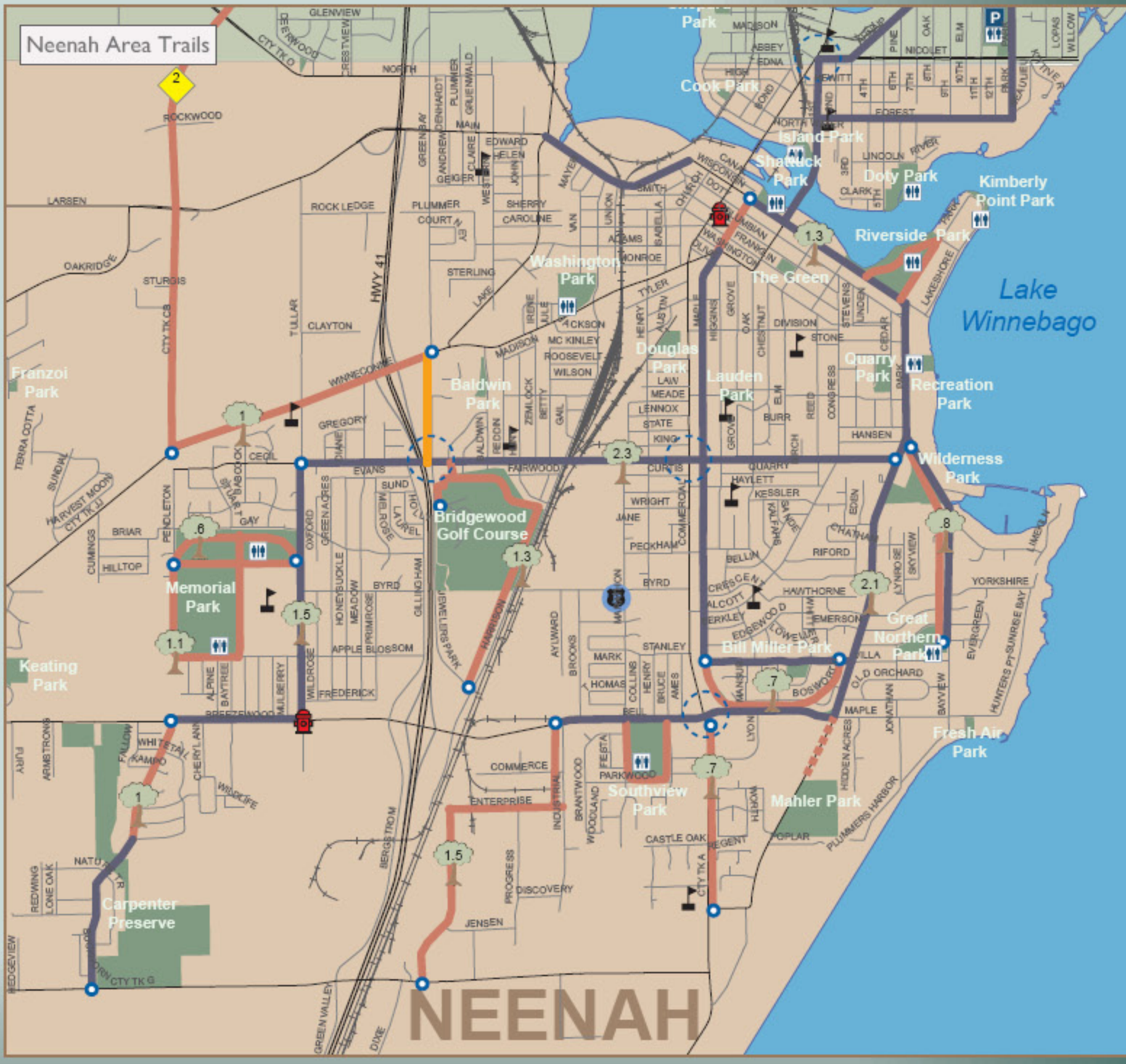

### TRAIL USE GUIDELINES

- BE COURTEOUS.** Bicyclists, joggers, walkers, wheelchair users, skateboarders, and skaters - Be respectful of other users regardless of mode, speed or skill.
- KEEP RIGHT.** Stay to the right side of the trail except when passing another user.
- PASS ON THE LEFT.** Look ahead and back to make sure the lane is clear before you pull out. (Faster traffic should yield to slower and on-coming traffic.)
- DO NOT BLOCK THE TRAIL.** Use no more than half the trail if you have a pet or are in a group.
- USE SIGNALS.** Give a clear warning signal before passing using voice, bell or horn.
- OBEY ALL TRAFFIC SIGNS.** Observe all the trails signs, including all traffic signs that control street crossings and intersections, trail speed, access to other trails, etc.
- CONTROL PETS.** Pets must be on a leash. Please clean up after your pet.
- NO MOTORIZED VEHICLES.** Vehicles, motorcycles, snowmobiles, ATVs, mopeds, etc. are not allowed on the paved, off-roads trails. (Except the Wiowash Trail. Please contact Outagamie County for information related to this trail.)
- WEAR APPROPRIATE SAFETY EQUIPMENT.** Helmets are recommended for all bicyclists.
