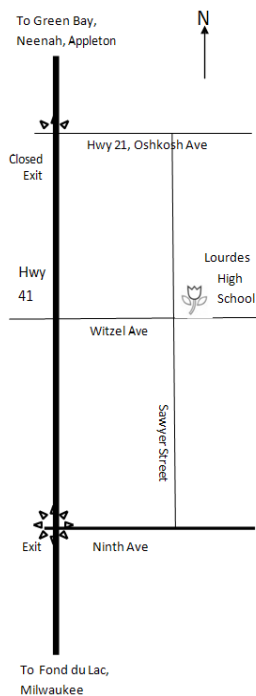

## Directions to the Quilt Show

Lourdes HS is on the northeast corner of Witzel and Sawyer. From Highway 41 take Exit #117 (9<sup>th</sup> Ave). Go east on 9<sup>th</sup> Ave 0.6 miles then turn left on Sawyer. In 0.4 miles turn right on Witzel, then take the first left on Josslyn Ave. Parking is available behind the school and on Josslyn Ave.

## Quilt Judge—Klaudeen Hansen

Klaudeen is a certified judge for the National Quilting Association and has judged competition quilts for a number of years. She also trains people to become judges. She is listed in *Who's Who in American Quilting* and is the editor of *Quilt Art Engagement Calendar* which features the work of regional quilters. She is also the editor of the *Address & Birthday Book* featuring miniature quilts and their stories. Klaudeen's quilts have been in many invitation shows both in the U.S. and Europe.

## 2012 Entry Rules and Information

1. Entry forms must be received by March 12, 2012.
2. The \$6.00 entry fee includes free admission to the show.
3. Entries must be delivered to Lourdes High School, 111 N Sawyer St in Oshkosh on Thursday, April 12, 2012, from 5-6:30 pm.
4. All quilts are required to have a 4" deep sleeve, the width of the quilt at the top, for hanging. Each entry must have a fabric label with quilter's name and address sewn onto the back of the quilt.
5. Entrants are responsible for their own insurance.
6. Lakeside Quilters Ltd reserves the right to eliminate a class if there are too few items entered. These will be reclassified.
7. Lakeside Quilters Ltd is unable to accommodate special handling requests.
8. Quilts must be picked up between 3:15-4:00 pm on Sunday, April 15, 2012. Claim checks must be shown when picking up your quilts.
9. Please attach a brief story about each quilt including: who made the top, who quilted it, techniques used (e.g., hand/machine quilting, piecing, and/or appliqué), why you made the quilt, and who will own the quilt. Additional information can be included as well. This information must be emailed to: [lizlahm.quilts@gmail.com](mailto:lizlahm.quilts@gmail.com) no later than March 12, 2012. If unable to email the information, mail it to Liz Lahm, 54 Gibson Ct., Oshkosh, WI 54902.
10. A judge will be critiquing all quilts. If you choose not to have your quilt judged, please indicate on the Entry Form.
