Steve will talk about all the steps in converting a tree into a bowl. This includes wood selection and how to figure out what type of bowl you can get out of the piece of wood. The purpose of the demo is for all those members who collect wood but have a hard time visualizing all the steps and decisions to get to that finished bowl.

Jamie Donaldson Demo on November 8 & 9 – by Cyril Griesbach

On November 8th and 9th we will be bringing Jamie Donaldson in from Kentucky as our featured demonstrator. Jamie is an accomplished turner and demonstrator and is a juried member of the Kentucky Guild of Artists and Craftsmen. He is also a member of the AAW and Louisville Area Woodturners. He has demonstrated at several AAW Symposiums as well as many AAW Chapters and is a frequent instructor at the John C. Campbell Folk School.

For our meeting on Saturday November 8th Jamie will demonstrate Square turning. As always when we bring in an outside demonstrator there will be an additional fee. For this time the fee will be \$25.00. The demo will be held at the Brigade. Please sign up with Barb soon.

On Sunday November 9th, also at the Brigade, Jamie will conduct a hands-on class for 8 to 10 students. The fee for the hands on class will be \$100.00. Students will be required to bring three pieces of wood 6"x6"x2". Make sure it's SQUARE. Damp but not wet wood is recommended and should be soft maple or some similar species. You will also need to bring in your turning tools (gouges, scrapers, chucks, drive and live centers, etc), and if you have one (or can borrow one), a mini lathe. At the Brigade we will have the club Powermatic, the club Jet Mini and the two Brigade Delta lathes available. If you must use one of these, sign up, with your fee, with Barb and get listed as using one of the available lathes. I know that several of us will be bringing our mini lathes for the class. We expect this opportunity to fill up fast so don't wait too long to sign up with Barb for this exciting opportunity to learn from one of the best.

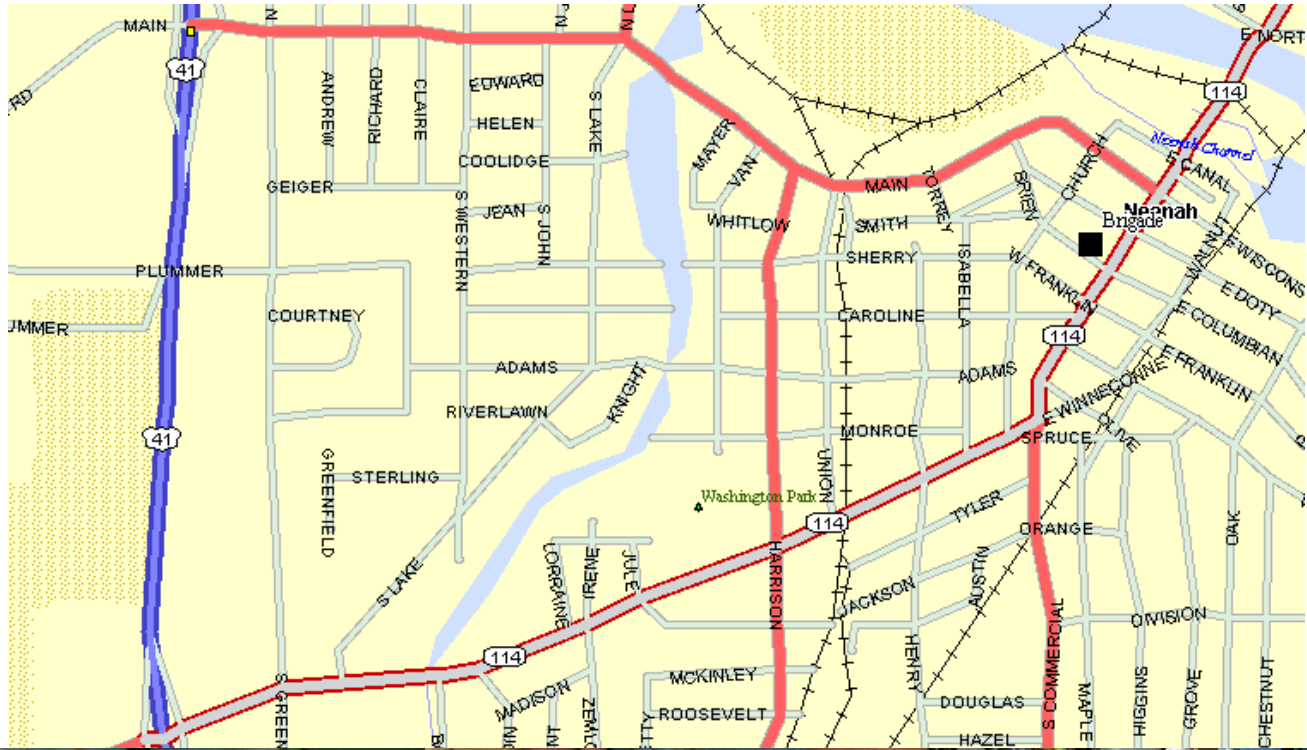
