-President Jeanne received a thank you from Harbor House for our donation of \$750 (our 'poinsettia money').

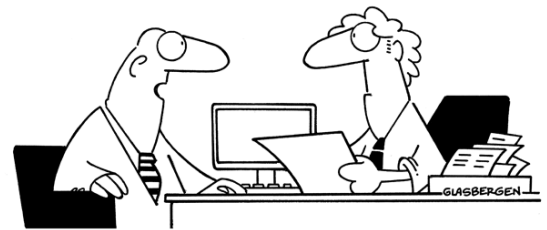
-Jerry Wood received a thank you from the Salvation Army for our Bell Ringing. There were a total of 38 hours that raised \$1,267.41.

Program

Bob Kinney introduced Rod Fisk from Development Partners, LLC. Rod is part of the Fox Village multi phase, multi building residential housing being built for UW Fox Valley students. The housing will room 250-300 students in 1000 square foot apartment style rooms with 4 separate bedrooms and fully equipped kitchen and dining rooms in each apartment. Buildings will each have 15 – 4 bedroom units and 1 – 1 bedroom unit (for the resident directors). There will be 3 levels of security with thumbprint ID locks. Cost per student is \$4,500 an academic year which is about 10-15% less than UW campuses. Buildings are energy efficient and will leave a small environmental foot print.
